



SUGGESTED FOUR-YEAR PLANNER FOR COLLEGE BOUND COLOR GUARD STUDENTS

The following is a recommended course of study for the college bound student. This schedule is an example of how a color guard member can meet the current requirements for UC/CSU admissions while fitting color guard courses into their schedule.

9th Grade Year

- English I or Advanced English I
- Math – Transitional Math, Math I, Advanced Math I, or Advanced Math II
- Biology
- Health/Computers Careers
- P.E. 9 or JROTC
- Performance Corps (aka Color Guard)
- Elective – Could be any number of elective courses (i.e. Jazz Band, AVID, Foreign Language, AP Human Geography, Leadership, Academic Seminar, etc.)
- * 8th Period Marching Band (After School/Evening Schedule)

10th Grade Year

- English II or Advanced English II
- Math – Math I, Math II, Math III, Advanced Math II, Advanced Math III, DE Math
- Science – Biology, Chemistry, Earth Science
- Modern World History, AP World History, AP Human Geography
- **Elective (1 Semester of P.E. credit is fulfilled through marching band)**
- Foreign Language I or II (Could be delayed one more year)
- Performance Corps
- * 8th Period Marching Band (After School/Evening Schedule)

11th Grade Year

- English III, Expository Reading & Writing 11, AP English Language & Composition
- Math – Math II, Math III, Advanced Math III, Calculus, DE Math, AP Calculus AB
- Science – Chemistry, Physics, Marine Biology, Environmental Science, Anatomy, DE/AP (Multiple Options)
- U.S. History, AP U.S. History, DE U.S. History
- Elective
- Foreign Language I, II, or III (Recommended)
- Performance Corps
- * 8th Period Marching Band (After School/Evening Schedule)

12th Grade Year

- English 92, Expository Reading & Writing 12, AP English Language, AP English Literature, DE English 101/103
- Math – Math III, Advanced Math III, MRWC (Math IV), Advanced Algebra Financial Apps, Math 90, DE Math, Calculus, AP Calculus AB/BC, Statistics, AP Statistics
- Science – 4th Year Optional but Recommended
- Government/Economics, AP Government, AP Micro/Macroeconomics, DE Political Science 101
- Elective
- Foreign Language II or III (Recommended) or IV (Optional) OR Elective
- Performance Corps
- * 8th Period Marching Band (After School/Evening Schedule)
